You may be aware that the NEU have announced further strike on **Wednesday 15th March** and **Thursday 16th March** because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay.

I'm writing to inform you that unfortunately all classes will need to close on **Wednesday 15th Match** and **Thursday 16th March**. We hope that you will appreciate that we have done our best to give you as much notice as possible.

We will only be open for vulnerable children and the children of critical workers in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. On strike days I must legally keep to infant class size ratios (one teacher to every thirty children) and if I have too many parents who are requesting that their children attend school, I may need to re-evaluate this at the end of the week.

If both parents are critical workers and you are requesting a place at school, then you must complete the following form by **3pm on Monday 13th March 2023** (please be aware that the survey will close at this time). I would like to point out that the Department for Education have asked schools to prioritise places for 'NHS staff and other emergency services to protect essential public services.'


