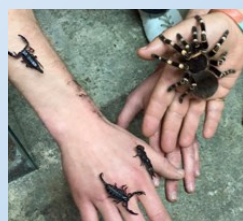
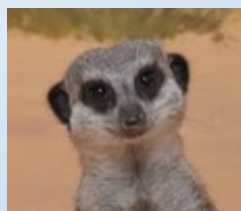




Animal Sanctuary visiting Year 1
