### Warm weather Reminders!

Hopefully the sun will come out soon, please make sure that your child has a sun hat (any hat as long as its labelled with their name) and a water bottle (any water bottle labelled with their name) with them in school. Water bottles must contain only water— **no squash or juice.** Please be aware that we are reopening water fountains in school this week, if your child has juice in their water bottle then this will be kept until the end of the day and children will be asked to use the water fountains.

Your child should also have sun cream applied before coming into school if we have a sunny day as staff are not able to reapply this during the day so we would suggest applying an all day type of sun cream before school.

Please don't send sunglasses into school as they're not necessary if children have hats, and do tend to get lost or broken!

The pollen count has been very high lately which may cause hay fever symptoms in some children - please speak to a pharmacist if your child is suffering from itchy eyes / sneezing / other signs of hay fever as they may need antihistamines and / or eye drops.

### Lateness

We continue to see a significant number of children who are late for school. This has a significant impact on learning (in all year groups) and is also unpleasant for the children who arrive in class after all their peers have started work.

Please be aware that you may drop off anytime between 8.45am and 8.55am. The classroom doors shut promptly at 8.55am. After 8.55am your child will be recorded as late. You will be asked for the reason that your child is late for school.

If you need any support please speak to the school office who will be more than happy to help.

### **Absence Reporting**

Can we remind all parents of the procedures for reporting absence:

- If your child is unwell you must call the office before 9.30am and leave a message, or you can email <a href="mailto:admin@parkgateinfants.herts.sch.uk">admin@parkgateinfants.herts.sch.uk</a>
- You must leave details of your child's name, class and the reason for absence please don't just say 'feeling unwell' or 'under the weather'. Please give specific details on your child's illness.
- If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea, we follow NHS guidance which states that children they must be off for 48 hours from the last time they were sick or had a loose bowel movement. This is to prevent the further spread of illness.


