### Attendance!


I have been concerned about the level of children's absence over the last few weeks. I know that young children are susceptible to spreading and picking up bugs and I would like to start by saying that we do not expect children to come to school if they are unwell.

Please though consider the attendance chart opposite (sorry it is a little grainy as I have scanned my paper copy). Good attendance should be above 96%.

Please be aware that if your child's attendance is 90% then they have missed 20 phonics sessions alongside 20 English and Maths lessons. This will lead to significant gaps in learning. As knowledge learning and skills at Parkgate Infants have a clear progression, these gaps need to be filled so that children are able to access other aspects of the curriculum when they are older.
